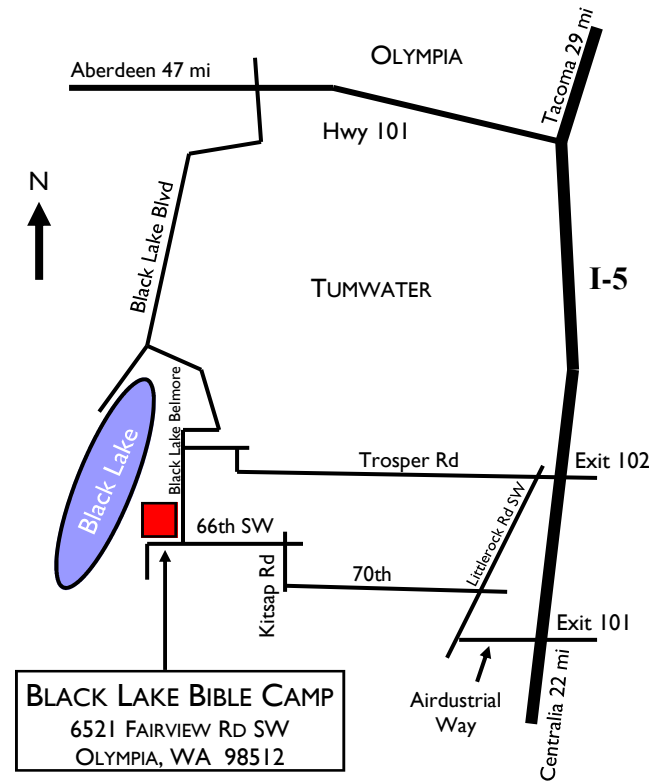


Rev. Jeremy Wilson
